Flat rate manual. The manuals list the repair time billable by tenths of an hour. For example, replacing front struts on a particular model will be listed as a 1.2 hour job. The OFFICE staff will take the shop labor rate of \$85 or \$95 or more, times the hour rate of 1.2 to obtain the labor cost for the work done for any repair.

You get paid your \$20 per flat rate to check it out. Next, if you find the leak at the water pump you then look in the labor time guide to estimate the repair for the customer. The guide recommended time to replace the water pump is 4 hours. Take the 4 hours x the shop rate of \$80 per hour and get \$320 to charge the customer for the repair.

Shops include much of their overhead into the labor rates, so what the shop charges you and what the mechanic gets are two totally different things. On average, a labor rate between \$70-\$100/Hr. is not unreasonable. This is so high to pay for lights, compressors, lifts, specialty equipment, etc...

Auto repair rates vary widely across the country, with rates ranging from as low as \$47 to as high as \$215 per hour. Know what you're paying for by understanding how car repair shops establish their rates, what mechanics typically get paid, and what overhead costs car repair facilities must pay to stay open.

Basic Flat Rate Billing. Let's say you take your car or truck in for a water pump replacement. The mechanic looks up the repair in his book, and it tells him that replacing a water pump in your vehicle takes 3 hours. You're billed 3 hours labor for the repair -- a flat rate based on what the book says.

* Some shops charge a flat rate for labor on auto repairs. This published rate is based on an independent or manufacturer's estimate of the time required to complete repairs. Other shops charge on the basis of the actual time the technician worked on the repair. Before having any work performed, ask which cost method the shop uses.

Before You Hire An Auto Mechanic An auto mechanic may charge you for his or her labor by using "clock hours," the actual number of hours worked on your vehicle, or by using a "flat-rate," the number of hours cited in a flat-rate manual as being standard for specific types of repairs.
